

The first experience comprises community project work and a challenging trek in a developing world context. The trip culminates in start-up events and workshops in Shanghai. Having identified opportunities in the world's fastest growing consumer economy, students then head to the US to learn first hand from the world's most productive ecosystem.

Leadership Development Expedition

Developed specifically around the themes of leadership, resilience and mindfulness, this Expedition challenges students to uncover their unique identity and explore the world beyond their own borders. The Expedition is a five week adventure in Thailand, Laos, Vietnam and China.

Study and travel now Pay later with HELP

Bachelor degrees are eligible for HECS-HELP and our global experiences are eligible for OS-HELP. This means you do not need to pay anything upfront.

What is HECS-HELP?

Through HECS-HELP, the government pays the cost of your course. You start repaying your loan through the tax system once you earn more than the compulsory repayment threshold of \$54,126* a year.

Am I eligible for HECS-HELP?

To apply for HECS-HELP you must:

- Be an Australian citizen OR hold a permanent humanitarian visa
- Have a Tax File Number
- Have a Commonwealth Higher Education Student Support Number;
- Not exceed your 2015 HECS-HELP loan limit of \$96,000*

Commonwealth Supported Place (CSP)

Government contribution of \$8,000 to total course fee. Available for Australian and New Zealand citizens, permanent residents.

How do I apply?

Once you're ready to take the plunge, our enrolment advisors will talk you through the simple online application process.

What is OS-HELP?

OS-HELP is a loan available to eligible students enrolled in a Commonwealth supported place who want to undertake some of their study overseas. OS-HELP can be used for a range of expenses such as airfares, accommodation, and other travel or study expenses.

Am I eligible for OS-HELP?

Students undertaking the Bachelor of Entrepreneurship or Social Entrepreneurship on Commonwealth supported places will be eligible for OS-Help provided they have not accessed OS-Help previously through another program.

When do I apply?

You do not need to apply until you have begun the first year of your degree, when our student support team will take you through the online process.

How do I repay my loan?

HELP repayments are based on how much you earn, NOT the loan amount. Your loan repayments are deducted by the ATO either weekly, fortnightly, monthly or yearly.

African Children's Stories



Peace Program


We support children to become advocates for positive change in their communities. Our Peace Centres and Peace Clubs provide a unique space for students to share ideas and promote the power of peace.
