Program Structure

The graduate certificate requires the completion of 4 subjects. Each subject has a credit point value of 3 credit points. You can study 2 subjects (6 credit points) over 8 weeks and achieve the postgraduate qualification in 4 months, although part time study is available.

Core Units

People and Culture

Examine what inclusion and diversity means in the workplace, how to strengthen organisations through employees and how to manage organisational change. You will reflect upon your own experiences and current people management practices to evaluate their effectiveness.

Leadership

Explore leadership in the context of the 21st Century and become better prepared to develop the necessary capabilities to prosper in this environment. You will reflect on your own experiences and biases to develop an understanding of how these influence your personal leadership style, was well as how you respond to the leadership of others.

Ethics and Decision Making

Engage with and reflect upon the ethical complexities of your industry, organisation through an exploration of behavioural ethics and business sustainability. You will learn frameworks, strategies and models that assist individuals and teams to make better decisions.

Finance for Managers

Attain an in-depth understanding about the field of accounting and finance and its real life application to a corporate or startup business environment. You will develop the confidence to use finance principals to make key management decisions and analyse business opportunities.

Course Pathway

Upon successful completion of the Graduate Certificate in Business Administration it is possible to articulate directly to the second trimester of the MBA (Innovation and Leadership).
